



## What you need to know about coming to Mass.

**You must book** a place at a **weekend** by phoning 01902 452841 or emailing etc.

Please leave a message on the phone if you call and no one is available.

**You do not** need to book a place **during the week** but will need you to give your contact details if we do not already have them.

### Before coming to Mass:

- 1) Please only come if it is safe for you.
- 2) If you or anyone you live with have Covid 19 symptoms please stay home.
- 3) Do not come to mass if you live with someone who is sick.
- 4) Note that toilets will remain closed.
- 5) Wear warm clothes as all windows and doors will remain open.
- 6) Get your mask ready to be worn at all times in church (under 5's exempt).
- 7) Remember Church will only be open 15 minutes before a Mass.
- 8) There will be a collection basket for each church at the stewards table on the way in should you wish to place an offering.

### Attendees must:

- 1) Wear a mask or face covering (over 5 years old).
- 2) Sanitise hands on entering & exiting
- 3) Listen to the stewards
- 4) Remain 1 metre + apart
- 5) Follow the signs

### During Mass:

- 1) Go to the seat directed by the steward. We will fill from the front of church.
- 2) You must stay in your allotted seat at all times
- 3) Holy Communion will be brought to you.
- 4) Holy Communion will be given in the hand only. If this is a physical problem for you please speak with Fr. Craig

- 5) There will be no singing or Altar Servers
- 6) It will not be possible to light candles when visiting the church.

### After Mass:

- 1) Please stay in you place until directed by a steward to move.
- 2) Make sure you take everything with you
- 3) Sanitise your hands when leaving.
- 4) Please maintain social distancing.

### Volunteers:

*All parish meetings and socials remain suspended.*

### How will the Church keeps your data:

For the safety of all who attend Mass, government has advised that contact details be kept for everyone who comes to Mass, for a period of 21 days.

That information will be destroyed after 21 days. I

t will be made available to the Track and Trace Service if they contact the parish to request that information. It will only be made available to any third party if it is required by law.
